CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Members who lodge an entry for any Club Championship event accept the conditions of entry. The Club Championships will be conducted in conjunction with the Laws of the Game and Bowls Victoria Rules for Competition. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter or amend the Club Championship program if necessary, or as required. Any decision made by the Tournament Committee is final.

Entry Fee:

The Entry Fee of \$10.00 per person for all Championship events to be paid at time of entry. Use the provided envelope, fill in details and place in Podium letterbox.

Closing Date:

An Entry Fee not paid by the closing date for entries will cause the entry to be deemed invalid. Entry fees cannot be refunded after closing date for entries.

Dress:

Club uniform is to be worn by players and markers on Day 1 and Finals Day of all Club Championship matches.

Game Times:

All players are to be available for play on Day 1 of competition. Each round of each event is to be completed by the stipulated date.

Singles Events:

If an entrant has drawn a bye in Round 1 they are to be available for duties as a marker.

Losers in each round are to act as markers in next round.

Club Minor Singles

You are ineligible to enter if you have:

previously won club minor, club singles or President's Handicap: Played in the top 2 sides for 5 games or more in Sat pennant in the previous season and/or current season: Played in the top side in Midweek pennant in the previous season/current season up to the closing date of the competition.

Practice on Day of Play:

There is to be no practice on the allocated green for the 3 hours preceding a Championship game.

Direction of Play:

Day 1 and Finals will be played in direction set down by the Greens Manager. All other days will be played in the direction displayed on the clubhouse board.

Scoring:

Scoreboards are to be used in all games.

Roll Up:

1 trial end to be played in each direction before each Championship game.

Substitute & Replacement Players:

After a team is constituted, should a player become permanently unavailable, a replacement can be made and can play skip. After a team is constituted, should a player become temporarily unavailable, a substitute can be made, but cannot play skip.

ALL SUBS/REPLACEMENTS MUST BE APPROVED BY THE CONTROLLING BODY (Tournament Manager or TM representative on the day)

PLEASE SEE ADJACENT NOTICE WITH DETAILED INFORMATION ON THE RULES SURROUNDING SUBS, REPLACEMENTS AND CONSTITUTED TEAMS.

Only the players who complete the final match of an event will be eligible for prizes.

Weather Conditions:

Players affected by a cancellation of play due to weather conditions/darkness are to arrange an alternative time/day of play. If the game is continued on the same day or a different day, the scores will be as they were when the game was stopped.

Heat: If during a Club Championship match, the temperature reaches 36 degrees C on our greens, then play will cease, and recommence as soon as possible when the temperature drops below the above limit. Play will recommence on the same rink.

Rain: If during a Club Championship match, play is interrupted due to rain, then the match shall continue as soon as possible on the same rink, when it is suitable to do so.
