

Garden Guru

Hi everyone, we have created a new garden at the end of the synthetic bowling green, and I am asking for all types of bulbs,:- tulips, daffodils, lilliums, iris any kind of flowering bulb. If you have any to spare, leave under the cover next to the garden and thank you. While the cooler weather at the start of winter enhances the sweetness and texture crops already in the ground, there are also ample opportunities to plant new seeds indoors or out. (I grow mine in the spare bathroom much to Marj's annoyance). June is also the peak time for bare-rooted vegetables, tubers and bulbs. So there is plenty of choice for what to plant ie leafy greens, peas, broad beans, rhubarb and early strawberries. This is your last chance to plant bulbs for fragrant flowers in Spring. Why not try asparagus crowns, the most tender asparagus spears are home grown. They are a long-term investment in your garden yielding delicious spears season after season often for twenty years or more. That's all for now. See you on the bowling green. Wally
